

The High School is currently following the Yellow/hybrid learning model where students who selected Face to Face will attend 2 days per week in their "A" or "B" Group ("C" Group students attend daily in Yellow). Fridays will be remote learning for Group A and Group B students while in the Yellow phase. Group C will attend in-person. **Please note the following revised schedule for the week of 1/18 – 1/22/21:**

1/18/21 Monday: Inservice Day (No students report to school)

1/19/21 Tuesday: A & C Report

1/20/21 Wednesday: A & C Report

1/21/21 Thursday: B & C Report

1/22/21 Friday: B & C Report (Last Day of MP2)

The free lunch waiver previously in effect until December 31, 2020, has been extended through September 30, 2021. Therefore, all students may receive a free breakfast and a free lunch daily through the end of the 2020-2021 school year and approximately one month into the 2021-2022 school year.

This applies to complete meals only and only to first meals. If a student opts to purchase a second meal, entree only, or extra fruits and/or vegetables, regular charges apply. Milk is available for packers and costs \$0.70/carton.

SENIOR PRIVILEGE for Face to Face students – URGENT INFORMATION! Senior Late Arrival and Senior Early Release privileges will be ending upon the completion of the first semester *for ALL students (even if your schedule does not change)*. Only Club Early release will remain in effect for the remainder of the year.

If you attend Face to Face and wish to have late arrival or early release for the second semester, applications are now available in the main office at Mrs. Loke's desk, or as a download on the HS website. Qualifying seniors (and juniors for this year only) will be approved based upon good academic, disciplinary and financial standing. *Note for Seniors only: the Career Readiness Portfolio (CRP) should be complete and submitted to/approved by the Counseling Office at the time your application is submitted; it **MUST be complete by February 24, 2021, or your privilege will be revoked at that time.***

Once your application has been reviewed, you will receive a status update email from Mrs. Loke letting you know if your application has been approved (it will include a start date) or denied (it will inform you of the reason for the denial). **You may not arrive late/leave early until you receive this confirmation email.** Please allow at least 24 hours for approval.

There will be NO SENIOR PRIVILEGE on Monday, 1/25 – the first day of Semester 2.
