SCHOLARSHIP SPOTLIGHT IN NAVIANCE!

Seniors - Check out the following scholarships posted in Naviance for high school seniors – **please see Naviance for more details:**

The Eric Stoler Nursing Scholarship is given to a senior who has been accepted in a post-secondary program in nursing, has a 2.5 or better cumulative GPA as of the 7th semester and must have demonstrated a sensitivity to people in need by participation in community service and/or volunteerism. The application should be submitted to the Counseling office by **March 30, 2021**.

MTEA Scholarship – Applicants must be accepted in an approved program of teacher education at an accredited college, university, or other certified institution. Scholastic achievement, service to school and community, and Financial need are requirements. The application should be submitted to the Counseling Office by **April 6, 2021**.

Scott Nyland Scholarship - Applicants must have participated in two complete seasons on any athletic team; or one year as a varsity letter winner on any athletic team, either as a participant or as a manager. Candidate should possess good character and citizenship qualities, good academic standing, and participate in activities. The application should be submitted to the Counseling Office by **April 6, 2021**.

The Robert Graupensperger Scholarship - The Rotary Club of Lancaster Sunrise has established a scholarship to benefit a graduating senior from Manheim Township High School who is in the top one third of the class, has been accepted at a post-secondary institution and can demonstrate a financial need. The application should be submitted to the Counseling Office by **April 6, 2021**.

The Alexandra Chitwood Memorial Scholarship – Applicant must be a first-generation student pursuing a 4-year college degree in Education, Counseling or Social Services. Scholarship application is due by **April 6, 2021**.
