- **LutherCare Nursing Scholarship** – Applicant must be seeking a degree in nursing. Applicants must compose an essay and are required to submit two letters of endorsement from a teacher, coach, counselor or community member. The application is due by **April 15, 2021**. - **The Heather Kappesser Scholarship** is a scholarship awarded to a senior who has participated in two of Manheim Township's Girls Varsity sports programs for at least three consecutive years and demonstrated a mature and respectful attitude toward peers and teachers.
