

Student Drivers: Please be advised that as we near the end of the school year the parking lots are becoming very full. This is a reminder that all vehicles are required to have a parking permit and must park in their assigned parking lot. There will be no warnings issued for students parked on school property without a valid parking permit and all unregistered vehicles will receive a parking violation.
