# Report Cards- 3x per year, parents will participate in Parent Teacher Conferences after marking period # 1 Reporting Key for Report Cards:

A "1" indicates at this time, the student is not meeting grade-level expectations. Performance is inconsistent with guidance and support.

- If a student receives a "1" in a particular standard area, the teacher will continue to work with the student throughout the remainder of the school year and will report future performance in this area on a later report card.
- A "2" indicates that the student is progressing toward grade-level expectations. Performance varies regarding consistency and level of support needed.
- This means the student is not quite independent with the skill at this time. The teacher will continue to work with the student throughout the remainder of the year and will report future performance in this area on a later report card.
- A "3" indicates that the student is consistently meeting grade-level expectations with little or no support. Performance is characterized by a thorough understanding of concepts and skills.

\*To increase the ease of communication, all areas of the report card will use the same key of descriptor levels.

- \* I am here for ALL students
- \* Talk with students about their feelings and behavior to help them feel and be their best.
- Work with students on social/emotional and behavioral skill development individually and/or in small groups
- Assess students to help determine their learning and behavioral strengths and needs
- \* Consultation and collaboration with YOU (parents!) and teachers
- \* Referrals for community services, outside agencies & therapists
- Work with the school counselor to teach students about a variety of topics such as emotion regulation and problem solving

## MY ROLE AS A COUNSELOR...

- \* I am here for ALL students
- \* Many factors go into kids doing their best at school focus and attention, relationships with peers, managing feelings & impulses, etc. I address these things using brief individual support, small group counseling, as well as monthly classroom guidance lessons in all classes.
- \* Referral process for students to see me
- \* Consultation and collaboration with YOU (parents!) and teachers
- \* Referrals for community services, outside agencies & therapists
- Work with students to handle student conflict and teach difference between conflict and bullying

#### IMPORTANT ATTENDANCE INFORMATION

- Attendance is an indicator of academic success and required by law.
- Notes from the doctor's office must be submitted to the office (can be faxed) if your child is seen by medical personnel.
- Doctor's notes are required after <u>10</u> absences of any kind (excluding any days that were covered by a doctor's note).
- ALL excuses must be turned in within three days. The absence will be marked unlawful
  if an excuse is not received within three days.
