 - School calendars are not on the district calendar
- Cycle days on calendar
 - Requested?
- Snow days & FIDs
 - Difficult to make everyone happy (conflicting preferences)
 - We can only use 5 FID days
 - Permission to blend snow days with FIDs
 - Two days to submit work following a FID
 - If work is not completed following a FID day, it becomes an "absent" or "tardy" on the student attendance record
- Managing student behaviors
 - Dealing with student trauma
 - \circ $\;$ Teachers/staff trained with trauma informed practices $\;$
 - Is there a plan to add more support classrooms?
 - We are growing in autistic support classrooms (hiring another teacher)

Question: How many teachers are retiring this year and are our salaries competitive? Teacher retirements are slightly low this year. Losing out on some teachers due to the lower salary but it has been adjusted now.

Question: We seem to have a lot of posting for Aids and support staff? We tend to respond to other districts who change their rates (Hempfield) so we have to compete. Difficulty bringing in entry level position employees.

Question about clearances: What events require security clearances? Typically it is the amount of time that the adult is left alone with children. This doesn't seem to be consistent across schools or classrooms.
